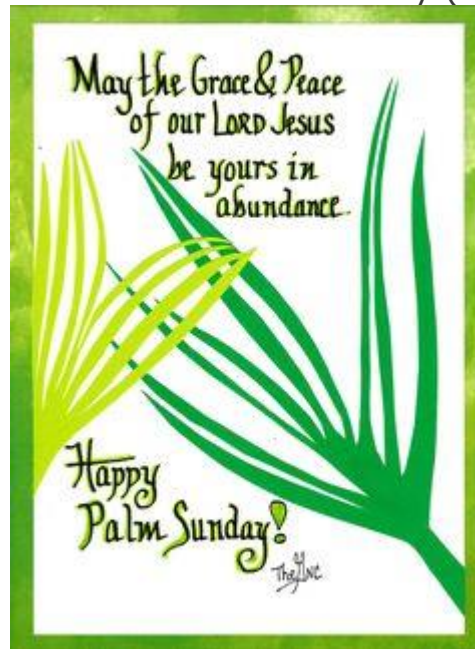


April 5, 2020 - The Church celebrates Palm Sunday (Passion Sunday), the
