- [Abraham House](#) – a home and community service center that serves as an alternative to prison for first-time offenders and offers afterschool and other programs for their families. Abraham House/Thrive for Life is located in the Bronx and founded by Catholic Religious.
- [The Guidance Center](#) of Westchester TGCW serves disabled individuals in New Rochelle and the nearby area
- [Abbott House](#) –a home located in White Plains for neglected and abused children.
- [Siena House](#)- a transitional shelter in the Bronx for women and their infant and toddler children. Siena House is run by the Dominican Sisters of Blauvelt and provides daycare, after-school programming and support for the Moms
- [Concourse House](#) - a transitional shelter in the Bronx for women and their infant and toddler children.
- [Hearts and Homes for Refugees](#) – Welcome and services for resettling refugees in the community
- [Fuller Center for Housing New Rochelle](#)- provides help after floods and fires in the community
- [Sacred Heart Parish Bronx](#) – Holy Family is giving hats and gloves to the young people in their religious education program.
- [Hour Children](#) – provides assistance to incarcerated and formerly incarcerated women and their families founded by Sr. Tesa CSJ
